#### APPLICATION INFORMATION

#### **Application timing**

Applications may be made at any time of year, except when the soil is frozen. When a spring application is made on fescue or bluegrass, a second application may be made during the summer after full seed head maturation.

#### Growth suppression and seed head inhibition

#### (Chemical mowing)

**MSM 60WDG Select** may be applied for growth suppression and seed head inhibition in well-established fescue and bluegrass turf at the use rate of 1/4 to 1/2 ounce per acre.

#### Tank mix combination

#### **Application timing**
