Control of ground ivy and Oxalis in cool-season turf



Trial objective

• To determine the efficacy of Sublime for controlling ground ivy (*Glechoma hederacea*) and *Oxalis* (*Oxalis stricta*) in coolseason turf height lawns


Materials and methods

- Trials were initiated on June 14, 2021 and conducted at the Virginia Tech Turfgrass Research Center (Blacksburg, VA).
- The plots were laid out in four replications on a cool-season turfgrass blend.




Trial results and conclusions

- Sublime provided the statistically fastest level of control against other herbicides.
- This unique combination works quickly with no bleaching symptoms observed.
- Sublime controls a variety of tough-to-control weeds.
