PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

SEED STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store treated seed in cool, dry conditions away from feeds and foodstuffs. **DO NOT** store excess treated seeds beyond planting time. **DO NOT** store treated seed in burlap bags or impervious bags/container or in areas that are poorly ventilated. **DO NOT** use empty seed bags for any other purpose.
