DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your state or tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

This labeling contains supplemental instructions and restrictions for use of this product which may not appear on the package label. Read and follow all precautionary statements and all other information appearing on the product label.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

SWEET POTATO "Seed Roots" -

Black Rot, Scurf, and Foot Rot: Dip the seed roots in a suspension containing 8 fl. oz. of THIABENDAZOLE 4L ST per 7.5 gals, of water (107 fl. oz. per 100 gals.).

Treat the seed roots for 1-2 minutes and plant immediately. Discard the suspension when the volume is too low or when it becomes dirty.

Do not use the treated roots for food or feed.
